- 8) the essence of leadership and management in the organization.

#### be able:

- 1) use acquired skills and theoretical knowledge of management to make management decisions;
- 2) apply the planning function to determine the perspective and future state of the organization, ways and means of achieving it;
- 3) apply the interaction organization function to divide the organization into units and establish authorities that connect higher levels of management with lower ones and provide the possibility of distribution and coordination of tasks;
- 4) apply the motivation function, which ensures the process of encouraging oneself and other employees to work;
- 5) apply the control function for effective management and selection of directions for the necessary corrections;

- 6) use various types of communications to establish an effective communication process both within the enterprise and externally;
- 7) apply approaches to management and leadership for the implementation of functions and formation of management methods in the organization;
- 8) classify management decisions and apply various methods of justifying management decisions.
