• leading Ukrainian and international directors, artists, screenwriters;

- prospects for the further development of scenographic art;
- outstanding contemporary choreographic productions;
- basic safety requirements for work on stage.

As a result of studying the academic discipline, students should be able to:

- create a basic script for a children's choreography;
- choose stage costumes for the created images;
- use decorative means to reproduce one or another artistic style;
- convey mood, emotions, using stage technical means;
- make a critical selection of means of expression.
