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FINAL EXAM ASSESSMENT FOR PHYSIOTHERAPIST (POLAND)

- How many parts (practical & theoretical - test, open questions, or both?)?

Theoretical test

- Where each part of the assessment is organized (e.g., in the health clinics with real patients? At the university? How long is the exam session?)

Medical Examination Center - MEC (State organization)

- What assessment protocols are used? (e.g., standardized forms at the university)

(40 questions prepared by experts from different fields)

- Who is involved in the assessment of graduates (e.g., university teachers, employers, representatives of the professional associations, other?)

Experts invited by MEC

- How the final grade in the assessment is determined (e.g., what are fail/pass requirements - for each part or all marks calculated together?)

(40 questions - minimum 50% to pass exam)

- Any other important information related to the final assessment.
